The parking lot maintenance job was announced and G.P.S. Line Striping, LLC. wanted to bid on it. Mr. Abernethy called the PTAC for assistance on the steps needed to bid.

The PTAC assisted Mr. Abernethy with reviewing the solicitation and setting up the mandatory site visit. After the visit, Mr. Abernethy was able to calculate pricing for the job. He scheduled another meeting with the PTAC and logged into the PA Supplier Portal for bid submission which was done at the PTAC office due to internet connectivity issues. Mr. Abernethy was awarded the \$5,000 contract.

While completing the work at the base, Mr. Abernethy was approaced by the contracting officer asking if he accepted government credit cards, which he did not. He asked the contracting officer why he stated that anything under the \$10,000 threshold they don't have to put it out for bid. This caught Mr. Abernethy's attention; he contacted his bank and within a month he was set up with capabilities of accepting credit cards. He is looking forward to getting future working from the base.

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
